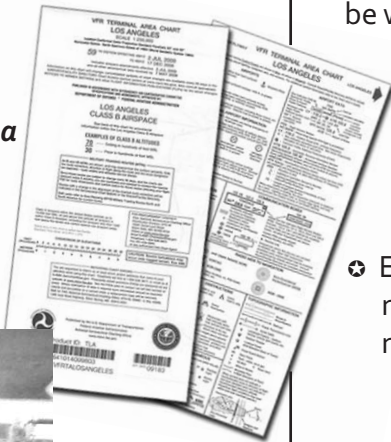

Gene Hudson will discuss System Safety principles and how to adapt them to non-commercial, single-pilot and single-airplane operations. He will examine various examples including:

- ✦ Identifying minor or innocuous indicators that something might be wrong that might alter the no-go decision.
- ✦ Identifying Safety culture indicators that renters should consider before renting an aircraft.
- ✦ Evaluating log books, maintenance entries and maintenance discrepancies

- ✦ What GPS receivers and installations are approved for GPS approaches?
- ✦ What are RAIM and WAAS capable GPS receivers, and why do I need to know?
- ✦ What approaches are approved for GPS?
- ✦ What are the kinds of GPS approaches?
- ✦ How do I read a GPS approach chart?
- ✦ How do I set up a GPS for an instrument approach?
- ✦ How do I conduct a GPS approach?
- ✦ How do I conduct a GPS missed approach?

He has authored an instrument flying book and several articles in aviation flying, human factors and aerodynamics.
